2. Extend the containment house on Range A to the berm. Materials will be on site.

3. Build a containment house for Range B. materials will be on site.

4. Bury two split barrels at the the ends of the eyebrow on Range F and install 4 inch pipe to carry the water down the back side of the

Service Rifle Match February 20, 2010 A Modified John C. Garand Match

The morning broke overcast and cool; there was a slight mist in the air and a mild wind. This was not a bad day to start the 2010 service rifle season, considering the weather a week or so before. It might have been a fun match to shoot during a record snow fall! Well, that is if you're one that likes snow, as for me I think the stuff is beautiful as long as it stays in places like New York or the Winter Olympics! How about that US Team?!

This match mixes a three position match, a rapid fire match and a medium distance match all rolled into one. All the firing was at 200 yards and was open to both vintage and modern service rifles. We had a great turnout for the season opener, 25 entries (some guys shot more than one rifle) and we had a couple of visitors join us as well. The results are listed below and on the club's website.

Division I Vintage Rifle:

- 1st – Stewart Alexander shooting an M1 Garand scoring 473 X 600 – 5X
- 2nd – David McCord also shooting an M1 Garand scoring 424 X 600 – 1X
- 3rd – Frank Bliss shooting his M1 Garand scoring 421 X 600 – 1X

Division II Modern Rifle:

- 1st – Frank Bliss with his M1A scoring 524 X 600 – 3X
- 2nd – Andy Mans shooting his AR-15 scoring 500 X 600 – 7X
- 3rd – Travis Bernsen also shooting an M1A scoring 494 X 600 – 3X

As you can see the shooting scores were close and the old M1 Garand still shooting strong. Keep in mind these M1's are over 50 years old now, older than most of the guys pulling the trigger! The M1A's did very well over the AR rifles in this match, a rifle that normally dominates the Division II group. Well done to all. I'm off to clean my AR.

Next Match:

Saturday, March 20, 2010: starting at 10 AM, registration starting at 9 AM – 200 yard prone match, timed fire shot in one 15 minute relay of twenty rounds fired on the "C" Range, SRC target. Open to Division I and II rifles. Awards for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place in each division.

Side Match: The Sniper – five rounds in two minutes from the sniper "hide." Any rifle, any sight, any rest using the U.S. Coast Guard hostage target at 200 yards! \$2 to enter, trophy to the best sniper.

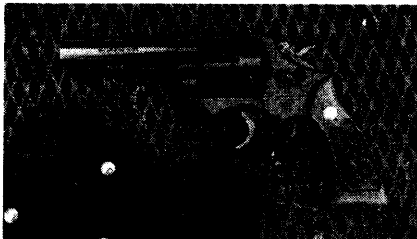

5. Extend the eyebrow 4 ft. using 1/4 inch mesh wire screen. We will slide 4 x 4's into the 4 inch steel tubing holding the present eyebrow. Then install the wire mesh on the 4 x 4's. Materials will be on site.
